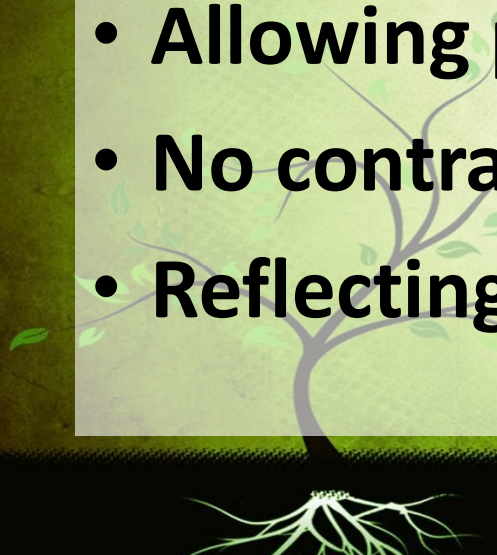


Biblical inerrancy

- **Free from error in the original manuscripts.**
- **“Truth can and does include approximations, free quotations, language of appearances, and different accounts of the same event as long as those do not contradict.” — James Montgomery Boice**
- **If the Bible contains errors, then we impugn the character of God.**

Bibliology - Inerrancy

- **Variety in styles**
 - **Different details of one event**
 - **Variance from verbatim writing**
 - **Variance in grammar usage**
 - **Allowing problem passages**
 - **No contradictions**
 - **Reflecting into translations**

- **How could an error teach truth?**
 - Is it right or is it wrong?
- **How could a holy God allow errors in His Word?**
- **Why doesn't everyone agree on what the "errors" are?**
