

“They Have Rebelled Against Me”

(Isaiah 1:2-20)



Introduction:

1 Samuel 15:23 – “For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry”

- Today, we need to examine our hearts for stubborn rebellion against God
 - I. *When we rebel*, we return evil for God’s goodness (v.2-4)
 - A. Rebellion is a failure to acknowledge God as the source of our blessings (v.2-3)
 - B. Rebellion is to forsake God for the sake of sin (v. 4)
 - II. *When we rebel*, we reap spiritual sickness & physical ruin (v.5-9)
 - III. *When we rebel*, none of our sacrifices & prayers are acceptable to God (v.10-15)
 - IV. *When we rebel*, nothing but full repentance can bring about full cleansing by God (v.16-18)
