Family Worship Guide

Memory Verse: Luke 11:23

Day 1: Read Luke 4:17-18, 8:28-31, 11:14-22, John 12:31, 1 John 3:8, 4:4, Isa 53:12; Col 1:13, 2:15; Acts 26:18; Eph 4:8 and discuss: Did it surprise you to learn there are only three seasons of intense demonic activity in human history? Why is there such strong activity preceding Christ's First and Second Comings? How does it affect your daily life to know Christ has such strength and power over the demonic realm?

Day 2: Read Luke 11:23-25, 39-41, John 8:44, Matt 5:20, 12:44, and discuss: What does it mean that there are no “spiritual orphans”? Why do some people think they can be spiritually neutral? What does their “spiritual neutrality” truly mean? What makes Jesus the most divisive Person who's ever lived?

Day 3: Read Luke 11:24-26 and Jam 1:15 and discuss: Why was the last state of the man worse? What happens to sin that remains in a person's life? Can you describe what this looks like, perhaps from your own life? Why do we fail when we put off without putting on, or in other words, repent without bearing fruit (as John the Baptist commanded in Matt 3:8)?
