Matthew 4:18-22 & Romans 10:14-15 And Selected Scriptures

Introduction: SEE: Lk. 5:1-11

"I will make you" - how did Jesus "make" them such fishers of men?

- 1. By His <u>example</u> (Jn. 4; Mt. 9:9-13)
- 2. By His <u>command</u> (2 by 2; Mk. 16:15; Mt. 28:19-20; Acts 1:8)
- 3. By His <u>enablement</u> (Jn. 15:7-8, 16)

I. Be a Fisher of Men!

- 1. Our "lake" is the <u>world</u> (Jn. 3:16; Mk. 16:15)
- 2. Our "net" is the <u>Gospel</u> (I Cor. 1:17-18, 2:1-5)
- 3. Our "fish" are lost sinners (Rom. 3:23)

Why did Jesus refer to evangelism as "fishing"?

- 1) Because evangelism like "fishing" requires patience
- 2) Because evangelism like "fishing" demands work and discipline
- 3) Because evangelism like "fishing" requires perseverance
- 4) Because evangelism like "fishing" requires dependence upon God

To share the Gospel is to proclaim:

An ESSENTIAL message (Romans 10:14-15)

- 1. The essential of <u>believing</u> the Gospel
- 2. The essential of <u>hearing</u> the Gospel
- 3. The essential of <u>proclaiming</u> the Gospel
- 4. The essential of <u>God's commission</u>

II. Why should I fish for men?

- A. Because of four calls to evangelism
 - 1. There is a call from <u>within</u> (Jn. 4:27-30)
 - 2. There is a call from <u>without</u> (Acts 16:6-10)
 - 3. There is a call from <u>above</u> (Mk. 16:15; Ezek. 3:17-18, 33:1-11; Mt. 28:18-20; Acts 1:8)
 - 4. There is a call from <u>below</u> (Lk. 16:19-31)
- B. Because we are God's only plan
- C. Because all men are spiritually blind (II Cor. 4:4)
- D. Because of the power available to us
- E. Because it is a <u>sin</u> not to witness
