## Family Worship Guide

Memory Verses: Philippians 2:12-13

**Day 1: Read Exodus 12:1-5 and discuss:** Pastor Scott mentioned two reasons it was important to note the Passover lamb was "without blemish" – what were those 2 reasons? What do these three verses tell us about Jesus? – <u>2 Cor.5:21; 1 Pe.2:22, 1 Jo.3:5</u>. Why is this important? According to <u>v.6 of Ex.12:62</u>, why did the lamb stay with the Israelites for 5 days?

Day 2: Read Exodus 12:1-6 and discuss: Why would the Israelites want to inspect their lambs? Was Jesus inspected? If so, by whom? Read Matt. 3:17, 12:18, & 17:5; what did God the Father think about the Son? Read Luke 23:4, 14, 22, 41, 47; what did the people in these verses think about Jesus?

Day 3: Read Exodus 12:1-7 and discuss: Besides 'his blood', what are some things people like about Jesus, or appreciate about Him (Christians and even non-Christians)? Why is his blood so much more important than any of these things? Read Matt.26:28, Rom.3:24; Rom.5:9; Eph.1:7; Col.1:14; 1 Jo.1:7; Rev.1:5, 5:6-7; from these verses what did the blood Jesus accomplish for us? What did it give him the ability to do?
