



### **JOEL 1:2** Hear this, you elders; listen, all you inhabitants of the land. Has anything like this ever happened in your days or in the days of your ancestors?








## 1. A DEVASTATING MESSAGE TO CONSIDER Joel 1:1-2



## What are words? Words are the mind and will expressed in thought or externally in written or spoken format.




# 2. A DEVASTATING MEMOIR TO COMMUNICATE Joel 1:3

Psalm 78:1-2 THE BOOK OF My people, hear my instruction; listen to the words from my mouth. <sup>2</sup> I will declare wise sayings; I will speak mysteries from the past—




Psalm 78:4 THE BOOK OF We will not hide them from their children, but will tell a future generation the praiseworthy acts of the Lord, his might, and the wondrous works he has performed.

## Psalm 78:5 THE BOOK OF He established a testimony in Jacob and set up a law in Israel, which he commanded our ancestors to teach to their children
