Q 25. Wherein consisteth the sinfulness of that estate whereinto man fell?

A. The sinfulness of that estate whereinto man fell, consisteth in the guilt of Adam's first sin, at the want of that righteousness wherein he was created, and the corruption of his nature, whereby he is utterly indisposed, disabled, and made opposite unto all that is spiritually good, and wholly inclined to all evil, and that continually; which is commonly called original sin, and from which do proceed all actual transgressions.

- 1. Define "want" Rom 3:11
- 2. Righteousness of Christ Rom 5:6-8

Corruption of His Nature

- 1. Utterly indisposed 1 Cor 2:14
- 2. Disabled 1 Cor 2:14
- 3. Made opposite to all spiritual good
 - a. "We are not sinners because sin we sin because we are sinners" R.C. Sproul
 - b. Only do what we want to do Jn 8:34
- 4. Wholly inclined to evil Gen 6:5
- 5. Continually Gen 6:5

Original Sin as the Foundation

- 1. All sin originates from original $\sin i.e.$ our \sin nature
- 2. Eph 2:2,3

Arguments Against Original Sin

- 1. Most are either:
 - a. Don't argue biblically
 - b. Appeal to "that's not fair" principle
- 2. Best argument says it contradicts scripture
 - a. Deut 24:16
 - b. Ezk 18:20
 - c. Individual culpability vs. corporate consequences
- 3. Roman Catholic/Semi-Pelagian (Arminian)
 - a. Rom 8:1, 4b
 - b. Rom 8:12-14

Q 26. How is original sin conveyed from our first parents?

A. Original sin is conveyed from our first parents unto their posterity by natural generation, so as all that proceed from them in that way are conceived and born in sin.^a

- 1. At conception Ps 51:5
- 2. It doesn't get removed
- 3. Points us to the "who"
