



but would keep His commands.



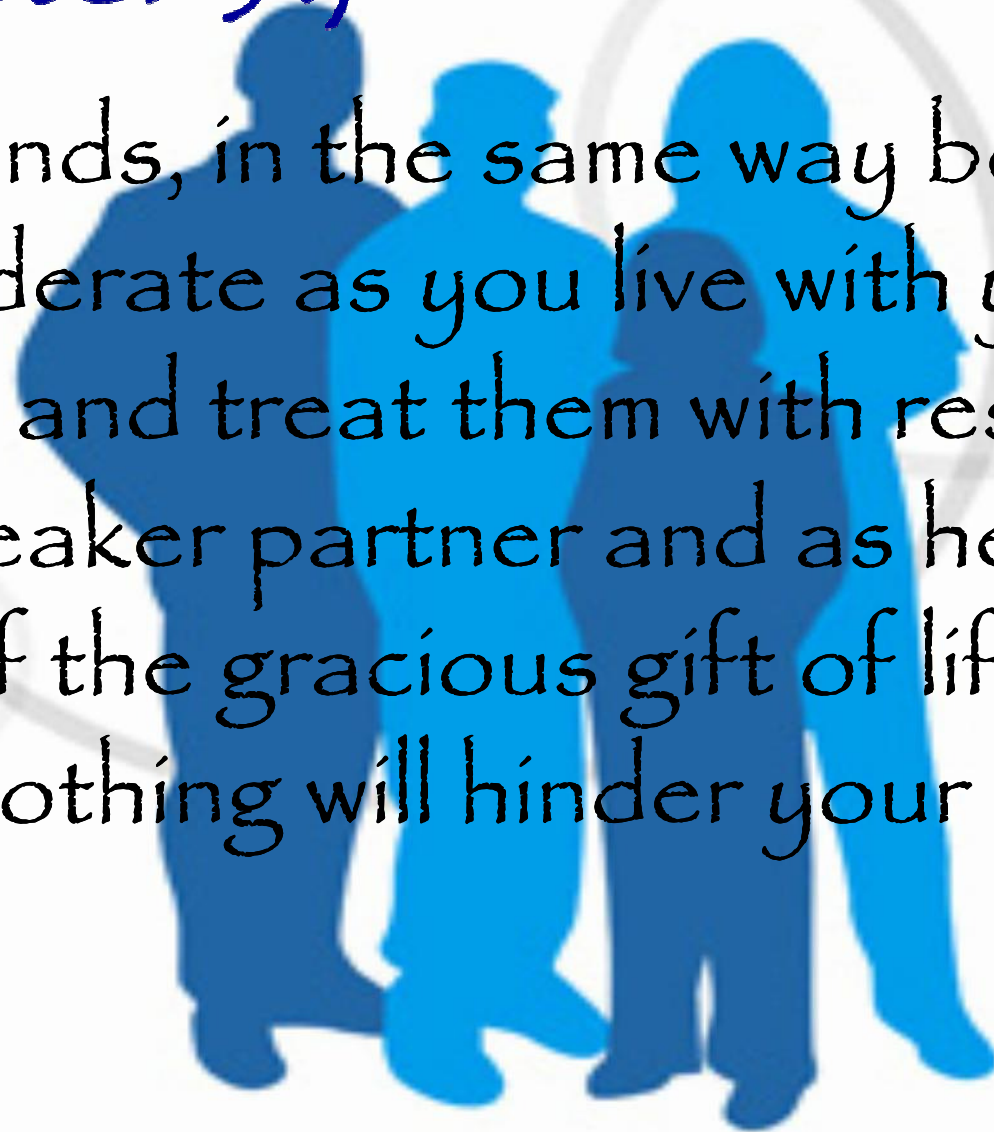
Ephesians 5:25-26

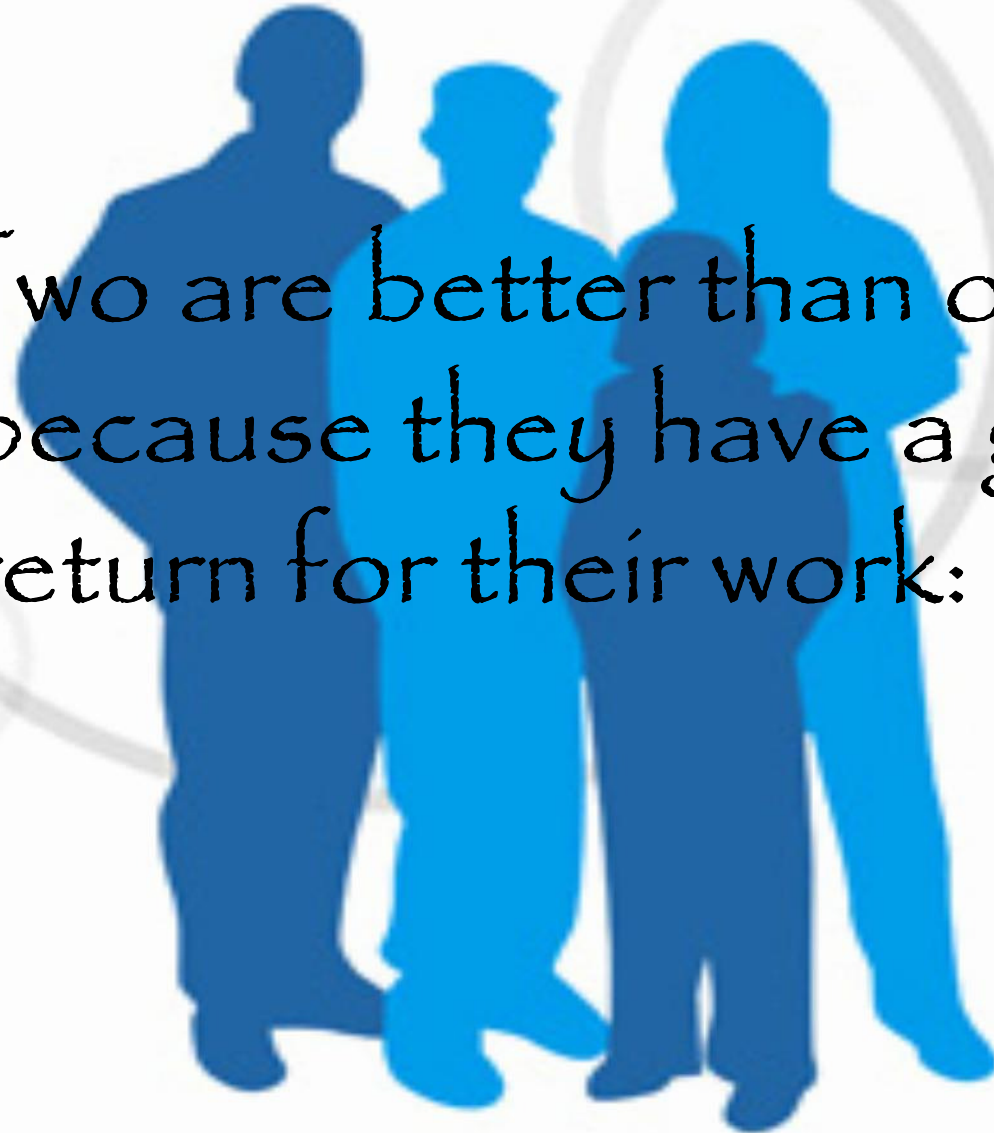

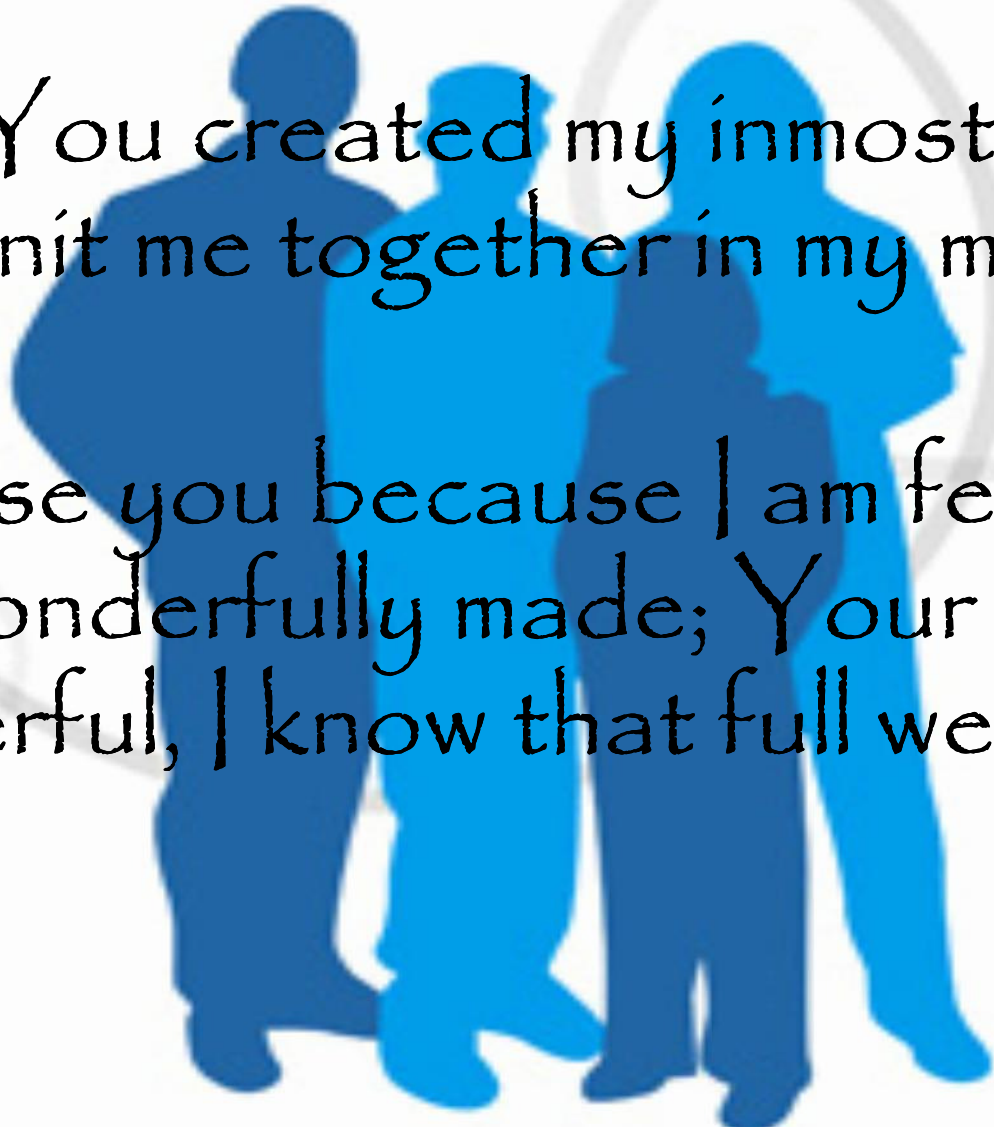


