Lesson 8 Reformed Worship: Glorifying and Enjoying God Together

I. The Nature & Purposes of Corporate Worship

- A. Corporate worship is the central event of the Christian life
 - 1. Our duty and delight
 - 2. The weekly, visible manifestation of God's covenant
 - a. God promises to meet with His people in mercy and love
 - b. God promises to bless His people with His gracious presence
 - 1) Worship is primarily *covenantal*, not evangelistic
 - 2) Worship is the main means of growing in grace
- B. Corporate worship is the primary way we glorify and enjoy God
 - 1. Praise, thanksgiving, and adoration (joyful, exuberant, NOT boring!)
 - 2. Communion with all three Persons of the Trinity

II. The Character of Reformed Worship

- A. God-centered (reverent, focused on God and His Word)
- B. God-engaged (dialogical principle of worship: two-way communication)
- C. God-ordered (regulative principle of worship; elements, forms, circumstances)
