⁷ Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.

⁸ Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. ⁹ Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: ¹⁰ But the seventh day *is* the sabbath of the LORD thy God: *in it* thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that *is* within thy gates: ¹¹ For *in* six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them *is*, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

¹² Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

¹³ Thou shalt not kill.

¹⁴ Thou shalt not commit adultery.

¹⁵ Thou shalt not steal.

¹⁶ Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

¹⁷ Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that *is* thy neighbour's.

QUESTION # 90: WHAT SHALL BE DONE TO THE RIGHTEOUS AT THE DAY OF JUDGMENT?

ANSWER:

AT THE DAY OF JUDGMENT, THE RIGHTEOUS, BEING CAUGHT UP TO CHRIST IN THE CLOUDS,^A SHALL BE SET ON HIS RIGHT HAND, AND THERE OPENLY ACKNOWLEDGED AND ACQUITTED,^B SHALL JOIN WITH HIM IN THE JUDGING OF REPROBATE ANGELS AND MEN,^C AND SHALL BE RECEIVED INTO HEAVEN,^D WHERE THEY SHALL BE FULLY AND FOR EVER FREED FROM ALL SIN AND MISERY;^E FILLED WITH INCONCEIVABLE JOYS,^F MADE PERFECTLY HOLY AND HAPPY BOTH IN BODY AND SOUL, IN THE COMPANY OF INNUMERABLE SAINTS AND HOLY ANGELS,^G BUT ESPECIALLY IN THE IMMEDIATE VISION AND FRUITION OF GOD THE FATHER, OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, AND OF THE HOLY SPIRIT, TO ALL ETERNITY.^H AND THIS IS THE PERFECT AND FULL COMMUNION, WHICH THE MEMBERS OF THE INVISIBLE CHURCH SHALL ENJOY WITH CHRIST IN GLORY, AT THE RESURRECTION AND DAY OF JUDGMENT.
