1 Corinthians 15:35-58

- I) The dead are indeed raised to life in Christ (35-44)
 - A) Death brings life (36-38)
 - B) Our earthly body is inferior to our resurrected body (39-44)
- II) Man's failure due to Adam; victory is in Christ (45-49)
- III) Our human bodies are not fit for heaven (50)
