Introduction - two things for us to remember as we consider the address of the Lord's Prayer.

- I. Prayer is conversation with God.
- II. The address of the Lord's Prayer is the foundation of prayer that teaches us how to approach God in our prayers.

Conversing with Our Father

I. Conversing with Whom

- A. Our Father, with whom we converse in prayer, is the Triune God: Father, Son, and HS.
 - 1. In the NT, the Triune nature of God becomes explicit, as we read in Matt. 28:19.
 - 2. The truth of the Trinity is the very basis of prayer.
- B. The Triune God is our Father!
 - 1. God is our Father and we His children because of adoption. What is included in adoption?
 - 2. What does this mean for prayer?
 - Application for bad family life or hurts in relationships.

II. Conversing How

- A. We speak to God with confidence when we pray through the Son and in the Holy Spirit.
 - 1. This confidence in prayer comes by the faith the Holy Spirit works in us (Rom. 8:14-16)
 - 2. We have this confidence in prayer because Jesus Christ is our mediator.
 - 3. Let us pray to our Father in this confidence.
- B. We converse with our Father in reverence because He is a Father to be honored, revered, and worshiped.
 - 1. Some have translated "Abba" in Romans 8 as Daddy or Papa. But this is not the right way to approach God.
 - 2. In our prayers, we must remember that we are to stand in awe of Him.
