Why did Jesus ride into Jerusalem on a Donkey? vv. 28-40

The expected behavior of Israel’s king

1 Kings 1:38–40

Fulfillment of Prophecy

Zechariah 9:9-10

A Miracle!

[30] “Go into the village in front of you, where on entering you will find a colt tied, on which no one has ever yet sat. Untie it and bring it here.

But what did they sweep aside? vv. 41-44

And when he drew near and saw the city, he wept over it, saying, “Would that you, even you, had known on this day the things that make for peace! But now they are hidden from your eyes. For the days will come upon you, when your enemies will set up a barricade around you and surround you and hem you in on every side and tear you down to the ground, you and your children within you. And they will not leave one stone upon another in you, because you did not know the time of your visitation.”

Two Lessons in these Events:

- 1. Jesus was making it clear for everyone in the future, that He is the Messiah/King/Passover/the New Exodus of God—The only Savior.**
- 2. Jesus was making clear for all future readers of history that through Him the Kingdom really has come.**
