Sometimes when we look back at things in history we gloss over difficulties and paint an ideal picture of those golden days. We face the same challenge with church history. If only we were everything the first century church was, we wouldn't have such difficulties. But the reality is that God's covenant people have always been a mixture of sinful people being transformed by His grace and sinful people who claim membership while continuing as traitors. Our great hope is not in our accomplishing anything as His Church, but rather His promise to make us completely holy. Let us yearn for that fulfillment and begin today acting like it by faith in Christ.

Ephesians 5: 25 - 32

Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her, that he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, so that he might present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish. In the same way husbands should love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself. For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ does the church, because we are members of his body. "Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh." This mystery is profound, and I am saying that it refers to Christ and the church.
