

RESURRECTION JOY John 16:16-22

March 31, 2013; Easter Sunday

- I. The joy of seeing again someone that you love
- II. The joy of coming to understand the meaning of the cross
- III. The joy of coming to understand the meaning of Jesus' resurrection
 - 1. today Jesus lives.
 - 2. we can have spiritual life
 - 3. we can be forgiven.
 - 4. though death will overcome these bodies of ours, God will resurrect these bodies and change them into perfect eternal bodies.
- IV. The joy that Jesus is here with us now
- V. The joy when Jesus comes again, and we see Him finally and fully and forever.

You can look *four directions* and find resurrection joy:

- 1. We look **back** at the cross where <u>Jesus</u> died in our place: forgiven
- 2. We look **up** to heaven where <u>Jesus</u> is now alive with all authority
- 3. We look **in** to <u>Jesus</u> with us forever
- 4. We look **ahead** to <u>Jesus</u> coming again

VI. Resurrection joy is always available.

Nothing can steal it away. Not:

- 1. Stuff.
- 2. Thrills, victories, accomplishments, adrenaline:
- 3. Memories: even memories can be forgotten.
- 4. Relationships?

So what took away your joy this week?

- 1. Was it finances?
- 2. Was it health? Pain? Fear of test results?
- 3. Was it relationships?
- 4. Was it loneliness?

In all of these things, we can look *back* to a crucified Jesus; *up* at a risen and ruling Jesus; *in* to find a present Jesus here with us; and *ahead* to a glorious coming Jesus. There is no joy like this joy: no one can take it away.
