RESURRECTION DELIVERANCE

1 Corinthians 15:29-50

Practical issues concerning the resurrection:

- 1. The resurrection speaks to <u>deceived</u> church members (v.29-34).
 - a. If there is no resurrection then religious observance is **meaningless** (v.29).
 - b. If there is no resurrection then taking personal risks for the gospel is are <u>senseless</u> (v.30-32a).
 - c. If there is no resurrection then pious personal <u>restraints</u> are pointless (v.32b).
 - d. If there **is** a resurrection then we had better strive for <u>holiness</u> (v.33-34).
- 2. The resurrection speaks to <u>deluded deceivers</u> that invade the church (v.35-42a).
 - a. Look at **agriculture** (v.36-38).
 - b. Look at the <u>animals</u> (v.39).
 - c. Look at the **<u>heavens</u>** (v.40-42a).

- 3. The resurrection speaks to <u>discouraged</u> saints passing through difficult times in a <u>diabolical</u> culture (v.42b-50).
 - a. We are going to receive a **<u>better body</u>** (v.42-43).
 - b. We are going to receive a **spiritual body** (v. 44-48).
 - c. We are going to receive a body with a <u>superior design</u> (v.49).

<u>Please note</u>: Flesh and blood <u>cannot</u> inherit the kingdom (v.50). This earthly body is not designed for heaven's <u>reality</u>.
