## Paul Suffered Greatly For Christ

Paul suffered greatly. Very few of us suffer as greatly as Paul. You have only to look carefully at 2 Corinthians 11:21-33 for the details of Paul's suffering for the Lord Jesus Christ.

## “Politically Correct” Preachers

There are today what we might call “*politically correct*” preachers. They preach only that which is “*politically correct*.” If Paul had wanted to be “*politically correct*” in a Jewish culture, he would have preached that Gentile men had to be circumcised like the Jews in order to be saved. Paul was persecuted by the Jews for not being “*politically correct*” by not forcing to be circumcised Gentile men who were saved.
