Romans 7:7-12

I.	The law sin (v. 7).
	(Romans 3:20; 4:15; 5:13; Galatians 3:19; I John 3:4).
II.	The law sin (v. 8).
	opportunity – referred to a starting point or a base of operations for an expedition
III.	The law brings (w. 9-11).
	The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law (I Corinthians 15:56).
IV.	The law rightly the character of God (v. 12).
	The law, like a tutor, leads us to instruction regarding God's character and His standard for how we are to live our lives and the obedience He requires. It also informs us and

enacts upon us the penalty incurred for failing to comply completely and perfectly with God's law. Its purpose is to prepare us, protect us, discipline us, and lead us to a day of

freedom – freedom in Christ.
