"Remaining Married through Thick & Thin"

I Corinthians 7:10-17

Introduction:

* Accept God's will for the life of your marriage!

I. Observe what <u>Jesus</u> taught about <u>REMAINING MARRIED (IN GENERAL)</u> (v.10-11)

- A. Do not <u>Depart</u> (v.10)
- B. Do not <u>Divorce</u> (v.11) [If you do separate, remain unmarried so reconciliation is possible - v.11]

II. Observe what <u>Paul</u> taught about <u>REMAINING MARRIED IN A MIXED MARRIAGE</u> (a believer & non-believer) (v.12-17)

A. If your unbelieving spouse <u>desires</u> you, REMAIN FAITHFULLY MARRIED (v.12-14)

Two reasons to stay married to an unbelieving spouse:

- 1. Do it for the <u>unbeliever's</u> sake (v.14a)
- 2. Do it for the <u>children's</u> sake (v.14b)

B. If your unbelieving spouse <u>deserts</u> you, ALLOW FREEDOM TO LEAVE (v.15-17)

Why "let him/her depart"?

- 1. You are not under <u>"bondage"</u> if he/she leaves you (v.15)
- 2. You are not sure if you can <u>save</u> your spouse (v.16)
- 3. You need to put the situation in <u>God's hands</u> and <u>trust</u> Him (v.17)
