Sermon: Consider Jesus, Continue Until the End

Scripture: Hebrews 3

## Introduction

- I. Consider Jesus the Apostle and High Priest of confession (v. 1).
- II. Consider Jesus counted worthy of more glory than Moses (v.2-6).
- III. Consider Jesus whose house we are if we continue until the end (v. 6b, 14).
  - A. Christians must maintain a confession of Christ until the end of their lives.
  - B. All who confess Christ do not continue; Israel in wilderness a good example (v. 7-11; 15:19; Ps. 95:7; I Cor. 10:11):
    - 1. Enjoyed privileges from God
    - 2. Rejected God through disobedience and unbelief (4:2)
    - 3. Consequences of their rejection
    - 4. What applied to Israel applied to Hebrew letter recipients and applies to us today (Mark 4:16-19).
  - C. Carefully examine yourselves (v. 12; I Cor. 10:12; II Cor. 13:5; II Peter. 1:10).
  - D. Encourage each other; don't become hardened, deceived (v. 13-19; Gen. 3:4-6; Prov. 5:3-6).
