Day 2: Read 1 Cor 1:17, 2:1, 2 Cor 11:6, and Heb 12:2 and discuss: What did people say about Paul's speaking ability? Does this encourage you? If so, why? Why does God want to use people who aren't gifted speakers? How can you

Day 3: Read Acts 17:22-31 discuss: What verses show Paul boldly preaching the truth, while remaining respectful? How might Paul have been tempted to water down the message? Why should people boast about their God versus criticize others' religion? What have your conversations with people regarding religion looked like? Is there anything you wish you'd done differently?
