

All Our Sins Laid Upon Jesus (Isaiah 53:6)

Vs 6 stresses the confession of sin common to all who are viewed here

This verse seems to focus on all of God's elect people through the ages

Every one of us are fallen & broken "we all like sheep have gone astray"

- This confession, while true of us all, speaks also of our own peculiar sins

We Have Turned Everyone to His Own Way!

I. Exposition of the Text

1. The LORD has caused all our sin to fall on Jesus Christ
2. Our sin was laid upon the suffering person of the innocent substitute
3. Laying our sins on Jesus, the innocent sufferer, was a just act of God

II. Application of the Text

Can you say this is true of your soul today? You have turned away?

If you can truly say this, then this Jesus died to save you from your sins.

Think about what Jesus had to do & endure to bear the sin of His people

III Conclusion

Why did God do this? Because of His love: For God so loved...He gave

Think about the security: In Christ we are secure, God will never judge us

All of the judgment that was because of our sin God judged in Jesus
