vs 12-20 Paul proclaims good news: God meets six of our deepest longings We receive of the manifold blessing of the resurrection- God is the center Six things in the text stir our longings for more of Christ

If Christ Has not been Raised ...

- 1. v 14: "And if Christ is not risen, then our preaching is empty"
- 2. Verse, 14: "... and your faith is empty"
- 3. We are false witnesses of God...we testified of God that he raised Christ
- 4. And if Christ is not risen, your faith is futile you are still in your sins!
- 5. V. 19 then "those who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished"
- 6. Vs 19 "we are of all men most to be pitied"
