This Sunday at CMPC...

This Sunday we return to our study of *Revelation: Strength for Today, Hope for Tomorrow* as we celebrate Palm Sunday and Pastor John looks at Revelation 19.1-10 and *The Original Hallelujah Chorus*. Then on Sunday evening Pastor Ben takes us into Luke 13 in our ongoing study *Luke: Becoming Certain About the Story*.

Our hymns will celebrate Jesus as king. We will gather with a late 20th century hymn, *We Will Glorify*. For our hymns of praise we will combine the 20th century chorus *Crown Him King of Kings* with the 19th century hymn *Crown Him with Many Crowns*. Our hymn of testimony will be the 21st century hymn *God, the Uncreated One*, also knowns as *King Forevermore*. We will then respond to God's word with *Blessing and Honor and Glory and Power*, Horatio Bonar's 19th century hymn.
