Mark 14:36 "Abba, Father, all things *are* possible for You. Take <u>this cup</u> away from Me; nevertheless, not what I will, but what You *will*." (See also Isaiah 51:17; Mark 8:34)

Luke 12:50 "But I have <u>a baptism</u> to be baptized with, and how distressed I am till it is accomplished!"
