The Key to Success in God's Kingdom Workers is Holiness <u>I. The details of Israel's experience emphasize this key</u>

A. Joshua and the people felt confident facing Ai: 6:27

- B. Joshua leads a serious and lengthy prayer service: vs. 6-9
- C. God's answer is shocking to Joshua & his elders: 10-12
- D. Application: Ps. 66:18

II. The stoning of Achan's family emphasizes this key

- A. Achan worshipped his idol above the LORD his God 1. vs. 20-21: the record of his sin
 - 2. vs. 13-15: the night-long appeal to his conscience ignored
 - 3. vs. 16-21: the sin uncovered and confessed
 - 4. vs. 25-26: the discipline of God
- B. What's God saying to us: all your sin matters big to Me!
 - 1. Listen to your conscience
 - 2. Search the deceitfulness of sin: where did Achan's sin start?

- 3. Are you hiding a sin in your tent?
- C. Application: Deal with your hidden sin before they are revealed 1. Numbers 32:23 – 1 Cor. 4:5 – Hebrews 4:12-13

C. The suffering of all Israel emphasizes this key

- A. God's verdict and actions did not touch Achan only1. Compare vs. 1a, 11-12; Joshua 22:20; 1 Cor. 5:6-7; 11:30-32
- B. Have you married into the toxic thinking of *individualism*?1. In God's eyes His people are *not an island but a body*
 - 2. Though you think sin is private or personal, God does not think so
 - 3. Search deeply to face your hidden sins (or not-so-hidden-sins)
- C. Application: come clear with God about your sins

Hypocrisy is nothing better than skin-deep holiness.

A man may have the tongue of an angel and the heart of a devil. (Flavel)

It is the mark of a hypocrite to be a Christian everywhere except where no one sees him or knows him.

The hypocrite has a crooked eye, for he looks more to his own glory than God's. (Watson)
