- Since Christ is the end of the Law, should we Christians concern ourselves much with the Old Testament or should we just read the new Testament? Why?
- What is gained by knowing someone's history rather than just knowing someone only in the present? How is this gain also realized in regards to knowing God via His self revelation in the OT and His self revelation in Jesus Christ as recorded in the NT?
- What is the whole story of which individual Bible passages are a part?
- Desiring to avoid them, what are some common mistakes in the way people approach the OT?
- Community Group Focus Questions: In general, what should we keep in mind as we read the OT in order
 to grab ahold of what God wants us to know from that record? What question(s) might we keep in mind
 when reading the OT to help us grab ahold of what God wants us to know?
