Kingship and The Great Commission

What does the believer's kingship have to do with the Great Commission?

→ Thesis: The Great Commission is an extension of the Creation Mandate.

I. Definition

-Creation Mandate: the promise of universal dominion which God made to His son, Adam, in the Garden of Eden [spreading the divine image throughout the earth; extending the garden-temple of Eden to the end of the earth; exercising dominion; all through the assistance of a helper.] (Genesis 1:26-28)

-Great Commission: the promise of universal dominion which God made to His son, Jesus Christ, in the counsels of eternity (Isaiah 42:1-4; Matthew 28:18-20)
