

Subject: God's Good News for All People

Scripture: Romans 10:1-15

THE GOSPEL SATISFIES GOD'S RIGHTEOUSNESS

- The inherent righteousness of God's character

Genesis 18:25 Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right? God is perfectly righteous. His character is unchanging. God cannot tolerate sin of any kind. God cannot change or compromise His character by overlooking sin. He cannot forgive sin without the penalty being paid for sin.

- The inadequate righteousness of man

Romans 3:10 As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one:

Isaiah 64:6 But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags.

- The impossible righteousness of God's law

Romans 3:20 Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the law is the knowledge of sin.

Galatians 2:21 I do not frustrate the grace of God: for if righteousness come by the law, then Christ is dead in vain.

- The imputed righteousness of Christ

2 Corinthians 5:21 For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

THE GOSPEL PROVIDES GOD'S RICHES

- The righteousness of Christ is available for everyone
- The righteousness of Christ is applied by faith

THE GOSPEL INVOLVES MAN'S RESPONSIBILITY

- Lost people must call upon the Lord
- Saved people must share the Gospel
