Immediately after the resurrection of Jesus Christ, a cover-up began to deceive people and keep them from the truth. Believers need to stand against deception and be powerful voices for God's truth in our culture today!

•		Disciples removed the body while guards slept.		

- whose testimony was given if guards slept;

- rolling stone failed to wake the guards??

- death penalty for sleeping;

- 2. "STOLEN BODY 2 THEORY" The authorities moved the body from the tomb.
 - authorities would have had every motivation to produce the body of Christ to stop the growth of the church, but they couldn't.
- 3. "THE WRONG TOMB THEORY" The women went to the wrong tomb.
 - That would mean everyone else went to the wrong tomb as well...impossible!
 - Roman or Jewish leaders would have produced the body easily.
- 4. "HALLUCINATION THEORY" The witnesses were hallucinating.
 - Hallucinations are highly subjective.
 - Do not persist for forty days over numerous sightings.
 - Hallucinations cannot be touched.
 - Over 500+ saw him so a "group hallucination" would be required virtually impossible.
- **5. "SWOON THEORY"** Jesus never died on the cross only swooned (fainted).
 - Shows ignorance of the violence of the crucifixion.
 - Shows ignorance of the injuries Jesus sustained.
 - The impossibility for Jesus to open the tomb and overpower the guards.
 - The impossiblity for Jesus to convince the disciples that He has power over death when He would have been so badly injured.
