Psalm 147:5 5 Great *is* our Lord, and mighty in power; His understanding *is* infinite. (NKJV)

Stephen Charnock "If his understanding is infinite, he then knows all things whatsoever that can be known, else his understanding would have bounds, and what hath limits is not infinite, but finite."

Isaiah 46:9-10 9 ... *I am* God, and *there is* none like Me, 10 Declaring the end from the beginning, And from ancient times *things* that are not yet done ... (NKJV)

Herman Bavinck "All things are eternally present to his mind's eye."

Isaiah 40:13-14 13 Who has directed the Spirit of the LORD, Or as His counselor has taught Him? 14 With whom did He take counsel, and *who* instructed Him, And taught Him in the path of justice? Who taught Him knowledge, And showed Him the way of understanding? (NKJV)

Proverbs 15:3 3 The eyes of the LORD *are* in every place, Keeping watch on the evil and the good. (NKJV)

Matthew 11:21 21 "Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the mighty works which were done in you had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes. (NKJV)

Steven Lawson "What a marvelous truth - God knows us the best and still loves us the most."

Isaiah 43:25 25 "I, *even I, am* He who blots out your transgressions for My own sake; And I will not remember your sins. (NKJV)

Steven Lawson "Though God certainly remembers our sins cognitively, He no longer remembers the sins of His people judicially ... All our sins are forgotten in their punishment, because Christ has satisfied the just penalty demanded by God."
