The government of Israel was corrupt –  
Isaiah was looking for a superhero

### **EL GIBBOR**

*God, the mighty One*

#### A. Jesus Christ, as God, has SUPREME AUTHORITY

##### 1. In defense of “EI” – what does it mean?

- Arguments of the critics
  - a. **The cults** – only a god
  - b. **The Liberals** – a god-likeness

- Answer of the Bible

##### **1st – Isaiah's perspective on “EI”**

Isa. 7:14 – Immanuel

Isa. 31:3 – “EI” is not a man

Isa. 10:21 – El Gibbor is a name for God

##### **2nd – Moses, Nehemiah, & Jeremiah**

Deut. 10:17 – Moses

Neh. 9:32 – Nehemiah

Jer. 32:18 – Jeremiah

##### 2. A Description of “EI” – who is it?

- Isaiah's prophecy was fulfilled  
Matthew 1:21-23
- John's Gospel is conclusive  
John 20:30-31

#### B. Jesus Christ, as God, has INFINITE RESOURCES

(Heb.) *Gibbor* – *to be strong, mighty, powerful*

1. As God He CREATED the world
2. As God He REDEEMED the world
3. As God He GOVERNS the world
