John 7:37-39 On the last *day*, the great day of the feast, Jesus was standing; and He cried out, saying, "If anyone should thirst, let him come to Me; and let him drink ³⁸ who believes in Me! Just as Scripture said, 'Rivers of living water will flow out of His inner being'." ³⁹ (Now, He said this concerning the Spirit, whom those who had believed in Him were about to receive; for the Spirit was not yet *given*, because Jesus was not yet glorified.)
