E. The Person and Work of Jesus Christ

- 1. The Deity of Christ
 - a. Argument By Truth
 - 1) Evidence From the Bible
 - a) Deity is explicitly attributed to Him and claimed by Him.
 - b) The attributes of God are possessed and manifested by Him.
 - c) All the works of God are performed by Him.
 - d) The worship of God is due to Him, offered to Him, and received by Him.
 - e) The titles and names of God are used to designate Him.
 - -El Gabor (Isaiah 9:6)

-The Son (signifies Messianic office; supernatural origin; eternal filial relation to, and equality with, God the Father (John 5:16-29; 10:22-39; 16:28; 17:5; Ephesians 1:3, 4; 1 Peter 1:2; 1 John 1:1-3).

- f) The seat of God's throne is occupied by Christ (Mark 12:35-37; 14:61, 62 with Psalm 110:1 and Daniel 7:13, 14. See also Genesis 49:13-19; Acts 2:33; Hebrews 1:3.)
- 2) Evidence From the External World
 - a) Jesus' position of kingship over the external world and His infallible control of all events demonstrate His true deity.
 - b) The dramatic impact which Jesus' life had and has on the course of history demonstrates His deity.
- 3) Evidence From Personal Experience
 - -When people come to trust Christ for salvation, they meet Him and know Him, not as a creature, but as their Lord and God.

Practical Significance of Christ's Deity: Jesus' deity underscores His divine authority; renders Him an accurate and complete revelation of God; guarantees the integrity of His claims; demands that He alone must be worshiped. Refusal to worship God the Son as the true God is idolatry (1 John 5:20, 21).
