- B. . . . God \_\_\_\_\_ us *Precious* In Christ; and *Valuable* as  
His Church, and *for* His Gospel, (Acts 16:4)

**Key Verses**—vv. 1-2: “*Paul came also to Derbe and to Lystra. A disciple was there, named Timothy, the son of a Jewish woman who was a believer, but his father was a Greek.*” (ESV)
