CONFESSION OF FAITH AND PRACTICE *(responsive paraphrased)*

Responsive Confession: *Heidelberg Catechism 31 & 32*

Elder: Why is Jesus called “Christ,” which means anointed?

Congregation: *Jesus is called Christ because He is ordained of God the Father, and anointed with the Holy Ghost, to be our chief Prophet and Teacher, fully revealing to us the secret counsel and will of God concerning our redemption.*

Elder: He is our only High Priest, who by the one sacrifice of His body, has redeemed us, and makes continual intercession with the Father for us.

Congregation: *He is our eternal King, who governs us by His word and Spirit, and who defends and preserves us in that salvation, which He has purchased for us.*

Elder: But why are you called Christians?

Congregation: *We are called Christians because we are members of Christ by faith, and thus partakers of His anointing.*

Elder: We are anointed that we may confess His name, and present ourselves as living sacrifices of thankfulness to Him.

All: *By this anointing, with free and good consciences we may fight against sin and Satan in this life, and afterwards we reign with Him eternally, over all creatures.*

SERMON NOTES

“A Faithful Saying”

2 Timothy 2:11-13

8 Remember that Jesus Christ, of the seed of David, was raised from the dead according to my gospel, **9** for which I suffer trouble as an evildoer, *even* to the point of chains; but the word of God is not chained. **10** Therefore I endure all things for the sake of the elect, that they also may obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory. **11** *This is a faithful saying:* For if we died with *Him*, We shall also live with *Him*. **12** If we endure, We shall also reign with *Him*. If we deny *Him*, He also will deny us. **13** If we are faithless, He remains faithful; He cannot deny Himself.
