

# I. Jesus is the Bread of Life (v 35; 51-58)

a – He alone can bring life into a lifeless soul.

b – He alone can bring lasting satisfaction to a hungry soul.

c – He is received through personal faith.

II. Those who receive Jesus as the Bread of Life do so only by the enablement of God the Father.

(v 37-40; 44-45)

a – Without God’s enabling, no one would receive Him.

b – Because of His enabling, many will.

1 – When they do, Christ keeps them eternally secure.

2 – When they do, Christ promises to “raise them up” on the last day.
