I. Jesus is the Bread of Life (v 35; 51-58)

- a He along can bring life into a lifeless soul.
- b He alone can bring lasting satisfaction to a hungry soul.
- c He is received through personal faith.

II. Those who receive Jesus as the Bread of Life do so only by the enablement of God the Father.

(v 37-40; 44-45)

- a Without God's enabling, no one would receive Him.
- b Because of His enabling, many will.
 - 1 When they do, Christ keeps them eternally secure.
- 2 When they do, Christ promises to "raise them up" on the last day.
