## Hebrews 12; Lord's Day 48 PRAYING THAT OUR FATHER'S KINGDOM COME

## I. The kingdom.

- A. God reigns as Sovereign over all as the Creator and Sustainer.
- B. The kingdom of Jesus' prayer is the Father's rule of grace in Christ willingly recognized and acknowledged by all its citizens.
  - It is God's rule being acknowledged (Heb. 12:28), because He established, and realizes this rule by the power of His grace.
  - 2. It is called the kingdom of Christ because God establishes and exercises His rule through Christ.
  - 3. It is called the kingdom of heaven because it is spiritual, not earthly (John 18:36a).
  - 4. The best description of the kingdom is "righteousness."
- II. The kingdom comes through-out history.
  - A. It was in Paradise when God ruled in the hearts of Adam and Eve; and through them He ruled over all.
  - B. When Adam purposely sinned, then Satan became the spiritual prince of this world (John 12:31; 14:30; Il Cor. 4:4; Eph. 2:2).
  - C. At the Fall God promised the establishment of His kingdom in the spiritual seed of the woman.
  - D. The kingdom comes about through the activity of its King.
- III. Jesus would have us pray for the realization of this kingdom, thought we cannot make it to come.
  - A. Personally, we learn to desire to be so ruled by His Word and Spirit that we may submit ourselves more and more to Him.
  - B. Also, we are asking that God preserve and increase His church.
  - C. Therefore, we ask that God destroy the works of the devil and of all violence which exalts itself against our King.
  - D. And may the perfected kingdom come with the return of Jesus.
