Theme: God's loving-kindness toward us is often revealed through the acts of His faithful servants. His kindness extends to those "outside" His kingdom and family – making them "insiders" who enjoy his provision and protection.

Background:

Leviticus 19:9-10; 23:22 - gleaning Leviticus 25:25f – laws concerning redeeming of land Deuteronomy 25:5ff – laws concerning Levirate marriage

Introduction: Inside or Outside?

I. Meet "Boaz"!

- We are in on the secret!
- Introduced before he enters the story.

II. The Fervor of Ruth

- A. They have to eat!
 - Gleaning?
 - Risky Business
- B. Seeks special permission (2,7)
- C. The field of Boaz
 - 1. Providence Disguised
 - 2. Look who's coming "Behold!"
 - ?? Whose young woman?
 - A detailed answer vv.6 & 7

NOTE: Ruth is shown to be an admirable character. She is a true Israelite!

III. The Favor of Boaz (8-9, 15, 16, 22)

- A. A well-known situation v.11
- B. Ruth gains permission
- C. Great Favor bestowed on Ruth!
 - Set on outer edge of the inner circle
 - "Most favored gleaner" as one commentator put it.

- D. Her great surprise.
 - 1. Favor to a foreigner?? v.10
 - 2. Seeking the blessing of Yahweh for her. v.12
 - "Find refuge under His wing"

E. Ruth moves from being an "Outsider" to "Insider."

- 1. Finding favor
- 2. Eating with the household

IV. The Report to Naomi

- A. Blessing comes to Naomi
 - Where were you? Whose field?
- B. Blessing the benefactor (19b)
 - 1. Before his identity is revealed
 - 2. After the discovery/revelation?
 - The Lord's **Kindness** (**Hesed** lovingkindness!)
- C. He is a close relative (near).
 - The hope of a *redeemer*.

V. Under the Lord's Wing

- A. The Unseen hand of the Lord
- B. Boaz's Prayer v.12
 - God uses him to help answer his own prayer
 - He is the instrument of the Lord's "wing" over her.

Application/Thoughts:

- 1. God's care for the poor
 - God to put his "wing" over Ruth and Naomi. v.12
 - How can we work to see the poor under His wing?
- 2. Coming from the "outside" to the "inside"
 - Jesus makes outsiders *Insiders!!*
