A. Definition of "covenant"

- 1. Human covenants (solemn agreements witnessed by God)
- 2. Divine covenants (sovereign administrations of relationship b/w God and man)

"A voluntary condescension (stooping down) by God by which He communicates Himself to man as the fruition of eternal blessedness and reward" (WCF VII:1). "A bond in blood, sovereignly administered" (O. Palmer Robertson).
