The transience of pluralism: from Christiandom to	Secularism
America always moving either closer to or further away from v12 And therefore from His blessing	
Our lament is <i>not</i> the passing of Constantinian Christiandom, but of the influence of the Gospel and Christian values in society	

Potential blessing: the less America is seen as a Christian nation, the more

the Church can be seen as a radical institution
