The High Priest's garments teach us...

1. ...that Jesus is the only mediator of His people. cf. 1 Tim.2:5
2. ...of the holiness Christ provides for His people.

3. ...of the vital unity between Christ and His people.
cf. Heb.2:10-14; Jn.15:1-8; 1 Cor.6:15; 12:27
4. ...of the particular love Christ has for His people.
cf. Heb.2:16-18; Eph.5:25,26; Jn.6:39,40; 10:11; 17:1,2;
5. ...of what Christ is making of His people.
cf. Lu.6:40; 2 Cor.3:18; Rom.8:29; Eph.2:10; 1 Jn.3:2
6. ...of Christ's sympathy for His people. cf. Isa.42:3; Heb.4:14-16
7. ...of Christ's guidance for His people. cf. 1 Cor.1:30
8. ...of the hope Christ secures for His people.
