I. HISTORY: "has been manifested" (vv.21-26)

- **A. Described:** "being witnessed" (vv.21-23)
 - 1. Evidence: "righteousness...manifested" (v.21)
 - 2. Method: "righteousness...through faith" (v.22)
 - 3. Need: "all have sinned and fall short" (v.23)
- **B. Displayed:** "God displayed publicly" (vv.24-26)
 - 1. Redemption: "being justified as a gift" (v.24)
 - 2. Propitiation: "propitiation...through faith" (v.25a)
 - 3. Forbearance: "passed over the sins" (vv.25b-26)

II. <u>HARMONY</u>: "justified by faith" (vv.27-31)

- **A. Concession:** "boasting...is excluded" (vv.27-28)
 - 1. Received: "excluded...by a law of faith" (v.27)
 - 2. Redeemed: "justified...apart from works" (v.28)
- **B. Consistency:** "God...is one" (vv.29-30)
 - 1. God of All: "the God of Jews...Gentiles" (v.29)
 - 2. God to All: "God who will justify...is one" (v.30)
- **C. Confirmation:** "we establish the Law" (v.31)
