To Some...

PSALM 119:

Because God’s “word” is

- True (29, 142, 151)
- Good (68)
- Endures (52, 152, 160)

God is... True, Good, Endures

Because God’s “word”...

- Blesses (1, 2, 135)
- Inspires all (161)
- Grieves over sin (136, 53)
- Stays pure, judges (9, 11, 101)
- Gives hope, Forgives (29, 66, 73, 104, 105, 111, 127, 130, 162)
- Advises (45)
- Commands (11)
- Lives (50, 93)

God Blesses, Inspires, Grieves over sin, Stays pure, Gives hope, Advises, Commands, Forgives, Lives.

How then should we live? Fear the God who's word it is

Psalm 119:120 (NASB)

¹²⁰ My flesh trembles for fear of You, And I am afraid of Your judgments.

To You?

- Will you hear these words as nonsense?
- Will you marvel?
- Will you treat the historic event as common?
- Will you tremble at His word, fear His judgments?

Return to your homes, as Peter did that morning, “marveling”.
