- I. The Challenge of the Kingdom (Mark 4:1-12)
 - Parables: wayside fowls/devoured; stones sun/scorched & withered; thorns choked & no fruit; good (kalos), yielded, increased & brought forth.
 - (9-10) He that hath ears... -; "unto you" vs. "unto them"; <u>alone</u>, <u>about</u> Him & <u>asked</u> them vs. "outside the circle" 1Th_4:12 honestly; 1Ti_3:7 report of; know/perceive
 - "That" having seen, see not, having heard, hear not Judicial
- II. The Caution of the Kingdom (Mark 4:13-25)
 - Stones (scorched; babes = nepios: cf. Saul/John Mark); thorns (cares/lusts: Solomon/Demas, 2Ti 4:10); wither; kalos ground (yield, sprang, bring forth & increased: David)
 - Ac 20:35 <u>I have shewed you</u> all things, how that so labouring ye ought to <u>support the weak</u>, and to remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how he said, It is more blessed to give than to receive.
 - 1Th 5:14 Now we exhort you, brethren, warn them that are unruly, comfort the feebleminded, support the weak, be patient toward all men.
 - <u>1Sa 10:6</u> And the <u>Spirit of the LORD will come upon thee</u>, and thou shalt prophesy with them, and shalt be <u>turned into another man</u>.
 - 9¶ And it was so, that when he had turned his back to go from Samuel, God gave him another heart:
 - 1Sa:28:19 Moreover the LORD will also deliver Israel with thee into the hand of the Philistines: and to morrow shalt thou and thy sons be with me: the LORD also shall deliver the host of Israel into the hand of the Philistines.
 - 2Sa 1:27 How are the mighty fallen, and the weapons of war perished!
 - 1 Kings 11:4 For it came to pass, when Solomon was old, that his wives turned away his heart after other gods: and his heart was not perfect with the LORD his God, as was the heart of David his father.
 - 6 And Solomon did evil in the sight of the LORD, and went not fully after the LORD, as did David his father.

- 7 Then did <u>Solomon build an high place</u> for Chemosh, the abomination of Moab, in the hill that is before Jerusalem, and <u>for Molech</u>, the abomination of the children of Ammon.
- <u>2 Pe 1:8</u> For <u>if these things be in you</u>, and abound, they make you that <u>ye</u> <u>shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge</u> of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 9 <u>But he that lacketh these</u> things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and <u>hath forgotten</u> that he was purged from his old sins.
- 1Co 3:1 And I, brethren, <u>could not speak unto you as unto spiritual, but</u> as unto carnal, even as unto babes in Christ.
- <u>Hebrews 6:</u>7 For the earth which drinketh in the rain that cometh oft upon it, and <u>bringeth forth herbs</u> meet for them by whom it is dressed, receiveth blessing from God:
- 8 But that which <u>beareth</u> thorns and briers is rejected, and is nigh unto cursing; whose end is to be <u>burned</u>. (Kausis vs. kaumatizo)
- <u>Hebrews 10:26</u> For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins,
- 27 But <u>a certain fearful looking for of judgment</u> and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries. (Not us! Though insecure.)
- (21-25) Take heart Candle; Take heed measure

- III. The Continuance of the Kingdom (Mark 4:26-34)
 - <u>Sower</u> riseth, knoweth not how; earth of itself & harvest w/sickle: "it's like that"!
 - Seed tiny & imperceptible to towering & infested
- IV. The Calling (or Crisis) of the Kingdom (Mark 4:35-41)
 - From the Particulars to the Practical: Exposition to experience!
 - 2 Pe 1:8 For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that <u>ye</u> shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.
 - 9 <u>But he that lacketh these</u> things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and <u>hath forgotten that he was purged</u> from his old sins.
