Dealing with Discouragement John 20:1-9

Renewed by our:

I. Faith – "whom He raised from the dead" (vs. 1-2)

Choosing not to:

- A. Forget "first day of the week Mary Magdalene came"
- **B.** Figure "saw the stone...taken away from the tomb
- C. Fear "They have taken away the Lord...we do not know"

II. Focus – "stooping and looking in, he saw" (vs. 3-7, 9)

Choosing the:

- A. Present "So Peter and the other disciple went forth"
- **B.** Presence "the face-cloth which had been on His head"
- C. Precedence "that He must rise again from the dead"

III. Friends – "the other disciple who had first come" (vs. 8-9)

Choosing friends with like:

- A. Experiences -"the other disciple...also entered"
- **B.** Expectation "and he saw and believed"
- C. Exasperation "For as yet they did not understand"

"The resurrection brings joy and a reminder of the hope of renewal through new life in Jesus."

- 10. What practical difference does Jesus' resurrection make in your life?
