- Treat the Deaf as you would any other image-bearer of God who is crafted according to God's masterful design and in need God's amazing grace.
 - Greet the Deaf when you come to church.
 - o Invite the Deaf in your community to attend our church.
- Call out to God for the salvation of souls from the Deaf community.
 - View the Deaf community as an unreached people group.
 - o Pray for the harvest of souls in the greater-Greenville/Powdersville area.
- Prayerfully consider learning ASL to communicate in the heart language of the Deaf.
- Partner with PBC by giving of your time, talents, and treasures to the Deaf Ministry.
 - Time: Attend the Deaf service at 3 PM each Sunday afternoon at 620 Powdersville Main.
 - O Talents: Volunteer to help provide rides, serve in the nursery or organize a youth group.
 - o Treasurers: Give financially during the 3 PM service.
