## To the Lamb upon the Throne (Rev. 5:8-14)

### II. The Lamb takes the scroll (v. 8)

- A. And when He took the scroll
  
- B. The four living beings and the 24 elders fall before the Lamb

### III. They Sing a New Song (9-10)

- A. A new song  
Climax of redemptive history demands a new song
  
- B. Worthy are you to take the book and open its seals  
Here is the resounding answer to the angel's question in 5:2
  
- C. Because you were slaughtered
  
- D. And purchased for God with your blood  
To purchase, pay a price to acquire someone.  
Rev. 14:3-4; 1 Cor. 6:19-20  
  
With His blood (Lamb imagery, violent, sacrificial death)  
1 Pet. 1:18-19
  
- E. From every tribe and tongue and people and nation  
All people without distinction, not all men without exception.  
An actual redemption, not a potential redemption.

"The Bible does not teach that Christ's death created the opportunity for men to be redeemed. It describes His death as 'redemption.' Remember what redemption is. It is 'freedom by the payment of a price.' Freedom! *So Christ's death actually secured freedom for those for whom He died.* . . .<sup>1</sup>
