Mark 11:1a

And when they came nigh to Jerusalem, unto Bethphage and Bethany, at the mount of Olives...

Mark 11:1b-2

...he sendeth forth two of his disciples, <sup>2</sup> And saith unto them, Go your way into the village over against you: and as soon as ye be entered into it, ye shall find a colt tied, whereon never man sat; loose him, and bring *him*.

Zechariah 9:9b

... thy King cometh unto thee: he *is* just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon [a donkey], and upon a colt the foal of [a donkey].

Mark 11:3-7

And if any man say unto you, Why do ye this? say ye that the Lord hath need of him; and straightway he will send him hither. <sup>4</sup> And they went their way, and found the colt tied by the door without in a place where two ways met; and they loose him. <sup>5</sup> And certain of them that stood there said unto them, What do ye, loosing the colt? <sup>6</sup> And they said unto them even as Jesus had commanded: and they let them go. <sup>7</sup> And they brought the colt to Jesus, and cast their garments on him; and he sat upon him.

Zechariah 9:9a

Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee...

Mark 11:8-10

And many spread their garments in the way: and others cut down branches off the trees, and strawed *them* in the way. <sup>9</sup> And they that went before, and they that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna; Blessed *is* he that cometh in the name of the Lord: <sup>10</sup> Blessed *be* the kingdom of our father David, that cometh in the name of the Lord: Hosanna in the highest.

Revelation 7:9-10

After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands; <sup>10</sup> And cried with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb.

Daniel 9:25a

Know therefore and understand, *that* from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince *shall be* seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks...

Daniel 9:26a

And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself...

Exodus 12:3b; 5a

...In the tenth *day* of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb, according to the house of *their* fathers, a lamb for an house: ... <sup>5</sup> Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year...

John 12:16-19

These things understood not his disciples at the first: but when Jesus was glorified, then remembered they that these things were written of him, and *that* they had done these things unto him. <sup>17</sup> The people therefore that was with him when he called Lazarus out of his grave, and raised him from the dead, bare record. <sup>18</sup> For this cause the people also met him, for that they heard that he had done this miracle. <sup>19</sup> The Pharisees therefore said among themselves, Perceive ye how ye prevail nothing? behold, the world is gone after him.

Luke 19:37-44

And when he was come nigh, even now at the descent of the mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works that they had seen; <sup>38</sup> Saying, Blessed *be* the King that cometh in the name of the Lord: peace in heaven, and glory in the highest. <sup>39</sup> And some of the Pharisees from among the multitude said unto him, Master, rebuke thy disciples. <sup>40</sup> And he answered and said unto them, I tell you that, if these should hold their peace, the stones would immediately cry out. <sup>41</sup> And when he was come near, he beheld the city, and wept over it, <sup>42</sup> Saying, If thou hadst known, even thou, at least in this thy day, the things *which belong* unto thy peace! but now they are hid from thine eyes. <sup>43</sup> For the days shall come upon thee, that thine enemies shall cast a trench about thee, and compass thee round, and keep thee in on every side, <sup>44</sup> And shall lay thee even with the ground, and thy children within thee; and they shall not leave in thee one stone upon another; because thou knewest not the time of thy visitation.
